Hey Everybody:

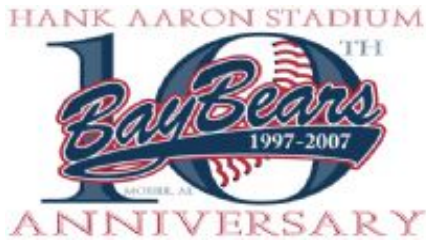
